Good afternoon,

We are sure that Year 11 are pleased that their final assessment period is nearing its end and want to again congratulate them for their mature and conscientious approach throughout. As promised, this letter provides further detail about the provision for Year 11 students for the remainder of the academic year.

### Expectations regarding attendance

As communicated previously, the Government has confirmed that schools are responsible for the education of all students up until the last Friday in June and have issued guidance outlining the types of activities schools might undertake during this period. We have now finalised our provision for year 11 students to ensure they are provided with an individual and appropriate programme of study to support their transition into post 16 education.

From Monday 17<sup>th</sup> May, Year 11 students will transfer to our individual transition provision, which will be accessed from home. Students will be provided with:

- Access to a bespoke Google Classroom containing resources and tasks for students to complete remotely which covers a wide range of topics, including transition materials for post-16, wellbeing, safety and careers. We have sourced quality content for these areas from external providers including EtonX, Speakers4Schools and Netsixthform and will be tracking which students have completed each of the assignments listed.
- Subject transition units. These detailed programmes have been designed to support students to prepare for Key Stage 5 learning and must be completed for all subjects selected for post-16 study at our sixth form. The link to this work is on the Google Classroom.
- Fortnightly tutor support and guidance mentoring.
- Access to school for study for those students who may need additional provision and support.

Students will only be expected to attend school:

- When they have scheduled assessments, in the Assessment 3 window or to support the completion of non-examined assessment. For students who have more than one assessment in a day, a quiet study room will be provided between assessments.
- For taught lessons, to support their academic progression to post-16 – Maths only.
- For specific calendared activities such as the Year 11 celebration assembly and post-16 induction days.
- When taking part in a range of enrichment activities (more details to follow).

**Please find an outline of the lessons that are still running from Monday 17<sup>th</sup> May at the end of this letter. Students should only attend school at the times indicated on this if they are in the groups mentioned on the timetable. These students will be asked to sign in and out at reception each time they come into school, so that our records of attendance are accurate.**

I hope this letter clarifies the arrangements and expectations for the final phase of Key Stage 4 for our Year 11 students. They have coped extremely well with all the disruption caused by Covid-19 and we hope that our plans for their final weeks of the year will allow them to end with some really positive experiences and memories of their time with us.
