Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope you and your family are well and beginning to feel excited about starting with us in September. We are all looking forward to meeting our new students and to getting to know you also.

We are now writing to update you on the work that has been going on behind the scenes in preparation for your daughter(s) joining us. Since you accepted your child's place at Northampton School for Girls, we have been in close contact with all the primary schools. This is so that we can learn as much as we can about your daughter to ensure we make their start with us as positive, proactive and supportive as possible. Transition Days
