


You will also need to meet our academic entry criteria:

3 A Levels at Grade B or above, one of which must in a numerical or businessrelated subject.

You'll also need Maths GCSE at level 6 (Grade B) or higher; English Language at grade level 6 (Grade B) or higher and three additional GCSEs at level 4 (Grade C) or higher.

MONTHLY YOUTH CAREER MENTORING PROGRAMME

This service is for young people in Year 12/13 who are starting to think about University or Degree Apprenticeship Applications.

A monthly mentoring session means that life after 6th Form / College is always on the radar....and that work is regularly being done to get you 'career ready.'

The mentoring programme initially works on Personal Branding, exploring free opportunities to show an employer or university that you are really interested in a sector. We're looking to find a great answer to an interviewer's question, "So you're really passionate about xxxxx - what have you done about that so far?"

We help you to develop a network of professionals within a sector who can provide support, advice and guidance. For example if you want to work in Law but have never spoken with a Solicitor or Barrister, we will help you to make that happen, and then coach you on how to get the most out of the meeting.
