- Submit the Northamptonshire County Council preference form, indicating your three preferences
 for a secondary school in order of preference. Further details may be found on the

- The Local Authority will inform parents of the outcome of school places on 1 March 2021.

Common Ability Test

ALL students applying for a place at Northampton School for Girls will need to sit the Common Ability Test on **Saturday 14th November 2020**, to allow the school to operate the fair banding process in accordance with its Admissions Policy. Further information will be e-mailed to applicants regarding test times once the online form has been submitted. The test does not require any preparation or revision. **Please note we cannot guarantee that we will be able to issue test appointments for applications received after the deadline** (5.00pm on 31st October 2020).

In addition to completing this form you must also submit the **Northamptonshire County Council preference form**. Their form is the one on which you indicate your three preferences for a secondary school, and must be returned directly to them, not to Northampton School for Girls.
